

Overview

DeVry University is offering a scholarship match of up to \$10,000 for qualifying students who are awarded a Delta scholarship* and who enroll as new, readmit¹ or alumni students in a certificate or degree program at DeVry University. Eligibility requirements and scholarship award guidelines are listed below.

Requirements and Selection Process	Final Selection	Students will be notified by Delta in May 2023, if they were selected for the scholarship. Delta will provide internal scholarship award to the student in August 2023. DeVry will provide its award disbursement in the Spring 2024 semester.		
	Process Timeline	January 31st, 2023: Deadline for internal Delta Scholarship Application. March 2023 - November 2023: Students may enroll at DeVry University. May 2023: Delta notifies their internal scholarship award recipients. June/July 2023: Delta provides DeVry the list of scholarship recipients and their award amounts. August 2023: Delta provides internal scholarship award to the student. November 2023: Deadline for scholarship recipients to start classes. Spring 2024 Semester: First DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award disbursement.

Restrictions	• Scholarship funds unused as the result of the student's ineligibility for continued participation for any reason, will remain undisbursed, and will never result in a monetary refund to the student. • Partial scholarship funds are not awarded to students who do not meet continued eligibility requirements. • Eligibility for Delta internal scholarship award does not automatically qualify a student for the DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award. Students must meet the eligibility requirements outlined in this overview document to receive the DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award. • Recipients of the Richard Anderson Trailblazer Award and the Delta Award for Excellence Certificate Scholarships are not eligible for the DeVry Delta Matching Scholarship award. • The match scholarship cannot be used in combination with other DeVry University group specific tuition rates or saving programs, including military, except the Delta Partner Tuition Savings of 30%. • Current DeVry University students are not eligible.

¹ Readmit student is defined as a student who has previously attended DeVry University but has not been enrolled in courses during the past 12 months or longer.
