

Completion Grant FAQ

The Completion Grant is designed to limit the tuition debt for students looking to advance their career ambition. Through DeVry University's partnership with Edcor, FedEx Ground employees are eligible for education benefits you can use to help you get back in school and reach for what you want.



What is the Completion Grant?

The Completion Grant is a program designed to provide a solution to limit tuition debt for qualified employees of FedEx Ground who enroll in eligible programs at DeVry University.

How can this program assist in limiting your tuition debt?

- DeVry helps eligible students prioritize the use of their FedEx Ground tuition benefits policy, such as tuition reimbursement or tuition assistance, which can help reduce your reliance on unnecessary federal loans (debt).
- DeVry will provide the Completion Grant for any eligible tuition and fees* that remain as a balance on an eligible student's account.

**Please note the Completion Grant will not cover optional bookstore charges.*

Who is eligible for the Completion Grant?

Only FedEx Ground employees who meet the eligibility criteria are eligible for the grant. New and readmit students who enroll at DeVry University in the May 2023 - March 2025 sessions may be eligible.

What programs are eligible for the Completion Grant?

Are there requirements for continued eligibility?

To maintain eligibility, you must take only one course per session, maintain continuous enrollment, and obtain a certain grade in each completed course based off FedEx Ground grade requirements.

03 Help find the right balance

Sessions start every 8 weeks.

To balance work, school, and life, consider 1 course per session, that way, you'll be on the path to earning your certificate (8 courses for undergraduate certificates and 6 courses for graduate certificates) at a manageable pace.²

04 Take advantage of your momentum

A certificate can allow you to learn new skills in a shorter time than a full degree program. Following the certificate completion, you may choose to stack it into one of DeVry's related degree programs.³ Reach out to learn more about embedded and stackable credentials.

05 Complete these steps to get started
