



UNCF DeVry University Gateway Scholarship Applicant FAQs: 2022



QUESTION 1

What is the UNCF DeVry Gateway Scholarship?

The United Negro College Fund (UNCF) DeVry Gateway Scholarship will provide a minimum of 30 eligible candidates each \$5,000 - \$10,000 in need-based or merit-based scholarships to students who enroll in one of the qualifying undergraduate or graduate certificate programs.

QUESTION 2

WHAT CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE UP TO \$10,000 UNCF DEVRY GATEWAY SCHOLARSHIP?

QUESTION 3

What is the length and cost of each of the certificate programs?

The certificate program completion time typically takes 8-18 months for full-time students depending on the program, not including breaks, and assuming year-round, full time enrollment.

QUESTION 4

What are the eligibility requirements for the UNCF DeVry Gateway Scholarship?

- 1. Must be Black or African American
- 2. Must be U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- 3. Must have GPA of 2.5 or higher
- 4. Must have transcripts uploaded to portal (High School or College) which include GPA
- 5. Must have a DeVry Official Acceptance letter
- 6. Must have completed FAFSA, if needed, and submitted any supplemental documents
- 7. Must have enrolled in one of DeVry's undergraduate or graduate certificate programs by the November 2022 session
- 8. Must submit a one-page personal statement of career interest of no more than 500 words

QUESTION 5

How do I begin the process of applying for the UNCF DeVry Gateway scholarship?

- Step 1: inquire with DeVry
- Step 2: a DeVry Admissions Advisor reaches out and guides you through the DeVry application
- Step 3: complete the Financial Aid application process
- Step 4: apply with UNCF for the Gateway Scholarship
- Step 5: UNCF & DeVry review applicants
- Step 6: scholarship recipients are selected and notified

QUESTION 6

Will the scholarship cover the total cost of the certificate program?

Most likely not. However, students may seek additional funding opportunities from other resources. You can talk to your DeVry Student Support Advisor for more guidance.

QUESTION 7

When will I receive the UNCF DeVry Gateway Scholarship funds from DeVry?

The deadline for the scholarship is October 18, 2022. It will take approximately 8 weeks for UNCF to determine who will be awarded the scholarship.

Once UNCF has provided DeVry with the recipients' names and award amounts, DeVry will award the scholarship within the first two semesters of enrollment. Scholarship funding and disbursement will be determined based on session start and dependent on length of program.





Qualifying students may receive up to \$10,000 (maximum lifetime award). The scholarship award winner will receive this amount over their first two semesters. The award will be divided into two disbursements with the following breakdown per semester. Disbursement of funds will be paid beginning the first semester of enrollment. Below is an example chart outlining scholarship award amounts and the semesters they would be awarded.

How long is this scholarship program available/active?

The scholarship application window is from July 20, 2022 through October 18, 2022

Recipients must be new or a readmit students who enroll in an undergraduate or graduate certificate program, included in the scholarship, at DeVry by the September or November 2022 session. A readmit student is defined as a student who has previously attended DeVry University but has not been enrolled in courses during the past 12 months.
